## How will the 'Following up on the 2022 ESA' event work?

The **'Following up on the 2022 ESA' event** is a workshop session in which participants will be able to take part in a live discussion regarding key issues to the future of the European Union and Higher Education communities across Europe. Taking the [2022 European Student Assembly's Policy Proposals](#) as a starting point, and convening the synergies brought to Barcelona by the THE 2022 European Universities Summit and the UNESCO World Higher Education Conference 2022, the event will address topics such as healthcare, cyber-security or climate refugees, among others.

After brief opening remarks, **participants will be divided into groups** and handed out different topics addressed by the European Student Assembly. In just a few minutes, they will analyse their assigned topic and discuss ideas to improve the 2022 ESA's policy proposals. Finally, the **groups will present their conclusions to the whole room**. The estimated duration of the event is **between 50 and 70 minutes**. Participants **will connect online or attend face-to-face at UPF**. To facilitate logistical matters groups will be entirely formed by either online or face-to-face participants.

## What is the purpose of the 'Following up on the 2022 ESA' event?

The main goal of the workshop is to ensure the ESA Policy Proposals are put into perspective and kept on the agenda, and to foster **a constructive, intergenerational, interdisciplinary environment of shared ideas**. By joining efforts in a unique opportunity for engaged students and responsive university leaders, new approaches and opportunities for our Union may come to light.
